# What Is HAP?

- **A volunteer-run nonprofit village dedicated to helping Hyattsville residents stay in their homes and remain active as they age in our community.**
- **Founded in 2011; a 501(c)(3)**
- **Provides volunteer services, educational and social events, and advocacy for older adults, available to City residents over age of 60.**
- **Funded through yearly membership dues of \$35, individual and business contributions, and grants.**

# HAP in 2024

- **88 paid members**
- **Received grants from the City of Hyattsville, Prince George's County Community Partnership and subcontracts adding to \$15,950.**
- **Collaborated with many, including Meals on Wheels, Central Kenilworth Avenue Revitalization CDC, Girl Scouts, sister villages in Cheverly, University Park, Greenbelt and College Park, DeMatha Catholic High School, ECO City Farms, Habitat for Humanity, and Franklins General Store.**
- **Co-founded Prince George's County Village Connection to encourage formation of new villages in the area.**

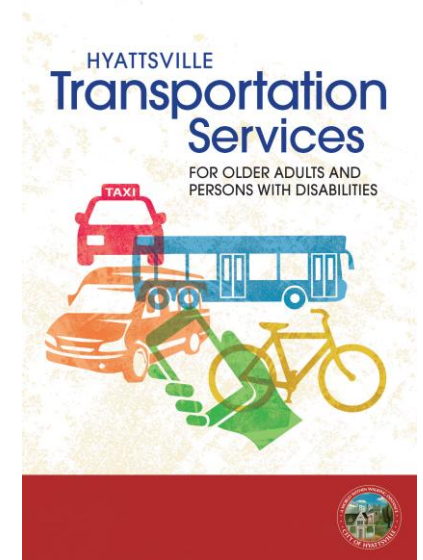
